ITEMS THAT CAN GO INTO THE CONTAINER

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Aluminum Cans
- Catalogs
- Plastic Bottles (all plastic bottles must have neck smaller than body)
- Magazines
- Milk Jugs
- Newspapers
- Phone Books
- Tin Cans
- Scrap Paper – examples:
 - Office paper* *Junk Mail*
 - Computer Paper* *Envelopes (with/without windows)*
 - Construction Paper* *Cardboard Beverage Cases & Carriers*
 - Wrapping Paper (no foil or plastic)* *File Folders*
 - Cereal & Cracker Boxes (remove plastic liners)* *Paper Egg Cartons*
 - Pizza boxes (no food)* *Paper Bags*
 - Tubes from: Wrapping paper, paper towels, etc.* *Shoe Boxes*

ITEMS TO AVOID

- NO Bottle Caps
- NO Medical Waste, sharps
- NO foil or plastic coated paper
- NO Paper Ream Wrappers
- NO Pet Food Bags
- NO Photographs
- NO Plastic Wrap or Bags
- NO Food-contaminated paper
- NO Paper cups or plates
- NO Waxed paper milk or drink cartons
- NO Juice cartons or Pouches
- NO Ribbon
- NO Frozen Food Boxes
- NO Snack Food bags
- NO Yard Debris
- NO Stickers
- NO Shredded Paper
- NO Candy Wrappers
- NO Tissue Paper
- NO Bubble-wrap, shrink-wrap or Styrofoam
- NO plastic tubs or lids (like margarine)
- NO plastic nursery pots
- NO GLASS of any kind*
- NO Motor Oil*

SCRAP PAPER RECYCLING GUIDELINES



- **Make a commitment to reduce the volume of paper you throw away.**
- **Buy and use products made from recycled material.**
- **Buy and use paper that is recyclable.**

ITEMS THAT CAN BE COMMINGLED

- Scrap Paper – examples:

<i>Office paper</i>	<i>Junk Mail</i>
<i>Computer Paper</i>	<i>Envelopes (with/without windows)</i>
<i>Construction Paper</i>	<i>Cardboard Beverage Cases & Carriers</i>
<i>Wrapping Paper (no foil or plastic)</i>	<i>File Folders</i>
<i>Cereal & Cracker Boxes (remove plastic liners)</i>	<i>Paper Egg Cartons</i>
<i>Pizza boxes (no food)</i>	<i>Paper Bags</i>
<i>Tubes from: Wrapping paper, paper towels, etc.</i>	<i>Shoe Boxes</i>

ITEMS TO AVOID

- **NO napkins, tissues, paper towels**
- **NO paper cups or plates**
- **NO foil and foil paper**
- **NO paper ream wrappers**
- **NO plastic or plastic bags**
- **NO photographs**
- **NO pet food bags**
- **NO food contaminated paper**
- **NO waxed coated paper or cardboard**
- **NO milk or drink cartons**
- **NO juice or beverage pouches**
- **NO ribbon**
- **NO frozen food boxes**
- **NO snack food bags**
- **NO shredded paper (confetti style)**
- **NO candy wrappers**
- **NO tissue paper**
- **NO non-paper items like paper clips**
- **NO rubber bands**
- **NO styrofoam**
- **NO binders**
- **NO cloth**
- **NO metal fasteners**
- **NO thermal paper**
- **NO tyvek envelopes**
