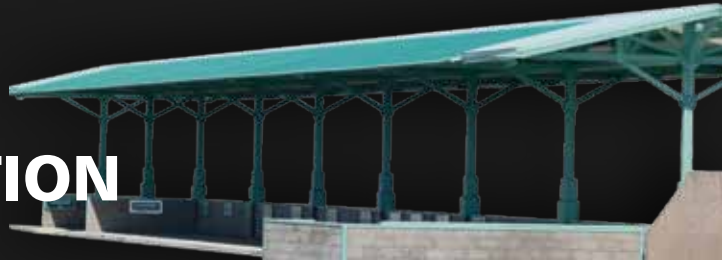


USING THE TRANSFER STATION & RECYCLING CENTER



LOCATION:

HOURS OF OPERATION:

9am to 4pm Mon-Fri

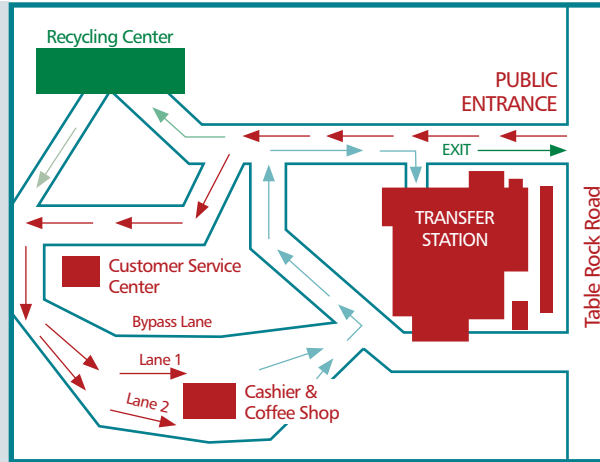
7am to 4pm Sat; closed Sun

Our busiest times are when we first open and from noon to 2pm each day

HOLIDAYS:

Closed at Noon: July 4th, Christmas Eve, New Year's Eve

Closed ALL day: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Years Day



WHAT IS A CUBIC YARD?

Cubic Yard =
27 Cubic Feet =
3' x 3' x 3'

Your load size is based on an inside measurement of your truck or trailer:
 $(L' \times W' \times H') / 27 = \text{cubic yards}$

WHAT TO BRING TO THE TRANSFER STATION

LOOSE MATERIAL:

MINIMUM CHARGE: \$17.40 for 1½ cubic yards or less *

ADDITIONAL: \$11.60 per yard³ *

- Household Trash
- Wood
- Boards
- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Wood Shakes

COMPACTED MATERIAL:

\$26.80 per yard³ *

- Drywall
- Demolition (w/drywall)
- Roofing (3 tab, Hot Mop)
- Dirt
- Rock
- Sod
- Bricks
- Carpet
- Wire, etc
- Sheet Glass
